



Safety and 200% Accountability

When it comes to what is important to us at Electric Boat, safety is always at the top of the list for all employees. One concept that can help ensure everyone is being as safe as possible is 200% Accountability.

This concept is basically looking out for yourself as well as your fellow employees. This can range from anything like letting someone know that their sparks from a grinding wheel should be pointed in another direction, to pointing out a trip hazard or material moving overhead and to avoid walking under it. These scenarios work as a senior employee looking out for a newer employee on the floor, as well as the other way around. By doing this, you are successfully practicing 200% Accountability, with you being the first 100% and your coworkers making up the other 100%. You are also practicing our Core Values by valuing each other, behaving with integrity and purpose, and committing to excellence by making sure you and your fellow shipbuilders are working in a safe environment.

SAFE DRIVING

Another notable topic of safety, which is brought up by many employees, is on-site traffic safety. There are concerns about parking lot safety in regards to speeding and not paying enough attention when traveling through the parking lots. With such crowded parking, vehicles can obstruct your view of employees walking through the lots. We must take this into consideration when driving through our lots, as well as inside the gates of the facility. We all understand that nobody wants to be late, and everyone wants to get home at the end of the day, but striking a coworker with your vehicle is not worth saving an extra minute or two and would likely be an incident that sticks with you for a very long time. By driving carelessly especially on EB property, you are not practicing any of our core values, because you are not valuing each other or behaving with integrity or purpose.

200% Accountability should also apply to driving on EB property as well – be aware of what’s around you and drive responsibly. By the same token, pedestrians should not be distracted and should be looking out for vehicles while walking. And remember, no running! At the end of the day, we all want to go home in the same condition we started the day in. Always obey the posted speed limits, use designated crosswalks and walkways. Don’t walk or drive while distracted.
