Electric Boat Quonset Point Fire/Rescue Vehicle

The EB QP FMO is proud to announce that Rescue 2 (2014 - Chevrolet Rescue Vehicle) has been placed in service. The Rhode Island Department of Health – EMS Division has inspected and approved the vehicle to be used for our EMS licensure. The vehicle is now listed as a primary response vehicle under our Rhode Island EMS Agency License. We currently hold a “non-transporting license” which means we cannot transport a patient to an area hospital or the dispensary at this time. A plan is in the works to transition this unit into a transporting ambulance in the future.

This new rescue vehicle will provide EB QP with many immediate benefits during an emergency. A couple examples would be the ability to place a medical patient or trauma victim into a climate-controlled, noise-controlled environment that also has privacy while being treated. This will aid the EB employee during high heat or extreme cold conditions, while we wait for the transporting ambulance to arrive on scene. During any long duration hazardous material incidents or fire related emergencies the vehicle could be used as a medical sector for triage, treatment, equipment cache during a casualty (or) the vehicle could be used as an emergency responder rehabilitation unit.

You will see the vehicle being used daily for the Fire Marshal’s Office work. The personnel who are assigned to the vehicle will also be performing their primary FMO duties in-between emergency calls. The vehicle during that period will be used to move about the enterprise but also keep our highly critical tools and equipment nearby should an emergency occur. This will ultimately reduce our response times to an emergency and allow FMO to arrive in a well-organized unit with a cache of medical supplies and life-saving equipment.
